



Professor Roman focuses on minimally invasive surgical management of endometriosis. He received his Ph.D. in epidemiology from Pierre and Marie Curie University of Paris and he accomplished a Fellowship in the Department of Pediatric Epidemiology of Charleston, SC, USA.

Horace Roman is affiliated with several professional organization, including the American Association of Gynaecological Laparoscopy. He is involved on the boards of the European Endometriosis League, the French Society of Pelvic and Gynaecological Surgery, as well as the Journal of Minimal Invasive Gynaecology (JMIG). He is recognized as World Authority on Endometriosis. He has several studies, publications on endometriosis.

Associate Professor Alex Ades is a highly skilled and experienced gynaecological surgeon specialising in Laparoscopic and Robotic Surgeries. He is renowned nationally and internationally for his expertise in Laparoscopic Transabdominal Cerclage and the treatment of cervical incompetence.






The evenings at memorial grounds are illuminated with the light and sound show. Entitled as 'Pride and Glory-The Story of Calcutta', the show traces the story of the glorious era of Calcutta. The show is also named as Sonet-Lumiere. It is highly recommended for everyone to attend the show.

The timings for light and sound show in the English version is from 7:15 pm to 8 pm.

Eco Tourism Park, New Town, Kolkata

This urban park is spread across an area of around 190 hectares of land, surrounded by 42 hectares of water body, thereby forming an island. The park is also called Prakriti Tirtha and is the biggest urban park in India.

VICTORIA MEMORIAL

The Victoria Memorial is a large marble building, which is considered to be the pride of Kolkata. Built between 1906 and 1921, it is dedicated to the memory of Queen Victoria and is now a museum. The garden is open from 5:30 am to 6:15 pm on all days. The Victoria Memorial Hall Museum or Gallery is open from 10am to 5pm from Tuesday to Sunday. On Mondays the Gallery is closed.



HOWRAH BRIDGE OR THE RABINDRA SETU

Located over the Hooghly river in West Bengal, Howrah Bridge or the Rabindra Setu is the main connection between Howrah and Kolkata. It is a cantilever bridge and is regarded as one of the busiest ones among them.



BELUR MATT

Belur Mutt is the headquarters of the Ramakrishna Math and Mission, founded by Swami Vivekananda. Situated on the west bank of Hooghly River, the temple is prominent for its architecture that embraces Hindu, Christian and Islamic styles and stands as an icon of unity of all religions.



JORASANKO THAKUR BARI

Currently located on the Rabindra Bharati University campus in Jorasank, Jorasanko Thakur Bari is the house in which the first non-European Nobel laureate and poet, Rabindranath Tagore was born.



KALIGHAT TEMPLE

Kalighat Temple, one of the 51 Shakti Sthals of India, is one of the most visited Kali temples in India. The spot is where the toes of Sati's right foot fell during Shiva's Rudra Taandav naach.



ECO TOURISM PARK

Eco Tourism Park is an expansive urban park designed to promote eco tourism in the city. It is the biggest urban park in India and occupies over 475 acres of land. The beauty of the location increases ten folds because of a water body that surrounds the park and forms an island in the middle.



MARBLE PALACE

The Marble palace near the Chorbagan in North Kolkata built in 1835 by Rajendra Mallick is famed for its art collection of masterpieces by Reuben and paintings by various renowned international artists such as Reynolds, Van Gogh and Rembrandt.



MOTHER TERESA TOMB

This is the place where the Tomb of Mother Teresa is present. It is maintained by her missionaries and followers who have continued to promote her legacy.



DAKSHINESWAR TEMPLE

Flanked by River Hooghly on the Eastern bank, Dakshineswar Kali is a revered Hindu navratna temple which is presided by Bhavatarini - a form of Goddess Kali. Built in Rani Rashmoni in 1855 who was a devotee of Goddess Kali, the Bhavatarini form means 'she, who liberates her devotees from the ocean of existence.'

Bawali Rajbari, 33.6 km
